Live From Nashville - Friday, September 12, 2014, 7:30 pm

Russian Quattro - Saturday, October 18, 2014, 7:30 pm

Born from two of the cello players of Rastrelli Cello Quartet, Russian Quattro is a fabulous new group featuring two violins and two cellos. Precise musicianship, down-to-earth stage manner and a bevy of classical favorites will make for a charming and unique evening of music. The program may include Tchaikowsky, Seant-Saens, Joplin, Vivaldi, Mozart, Kreisler, Pablo de Sarasate, Van Heusen, Drabkin, Gilkyson and Gershwin.



Atlanta Rhythm Section - Sunday, November 16, 2014, 2:30 pm

Often described as a more radio-friendly version of Lynyrd Skynyrd or the Allman Brothers, the Atlanta Rhythm Section was one of the few Southern rock bands to hit the upper reaches of the charts during the late 1970s. They will be playing the hits as well as some deep ARS album cuts like "Dog Days" and "Do It Or Die" - fan favorites that haven't been performed in more than 20 years.

Al Simmons - Saturday, February 14, 2015, 7:30 pm

Al Simmon's concerts are full of bizarre gadgets, wild costumes, witty songs, ingenious vaudeville-inspired routines and, of course, bad puns. With his collection of homemade mechanical hats and inspired musical contraptions it's no wonder he has been called "The Thomas Edison of entertainers."
